The meeting was called to order at 9:00am.

Gene Davis opened the meeting in prayer.

**Agenda:** There is one change to the agenda. The budget will not be adopted today. That will take place at next month's meeting. Vanessa Hernandez made a motion and was seconded by Doug Jensen to accept the agenda with the change. Motion passed unanimously.

**Minutes:** Vanessa Hernandez made a motion and was seconded by Mike Prescott to approve the minutes as printed. Motion passed unanimously.

***Draft RFP for Website Development and Design & Logo Update***

Krystin Chapman brought the draft RFP before the Board. It had been reviewed by Attorney Evers and he made just a few changes. Krystin Chapman announced the changes to the Board. She feels that it is time to update our website and our logo since internet presence is very important to businesses. Donald Samuels made a motion and was seconded by Doug Jensen to approve the RFP. Motion passed unanimously.

***Retention Pond, Culvert Crossing, Conceptual Development Plan of Commerce Park Expansion*** John Schneider from Hunter Engineering came before the Board and explained the maps for the expansion of the Commerce Park. The maps are a preliminary layout and the lots are roughly 4-5 acres a piece. Donald Samuels made a motion and was seconded by Doug Jensen for Hunter Engineering to proceed with a formal set of plans with reviews as the process moves along. Motion passed unanimously.

**Update on EDA rankings**

Director Lambert gave an update on the rankings. The cities of Bowling Green and Zolfo Springs have already ranked the projects. The BoCC has ranked them as well. The spec building was the top choice for the BoCC.

**Draft 2013-2014 Budget**

Sarah Pelham came before the Board and wanted to know if there were any changes that needed to be made before it is finalized. No Board members noted any changes. Sarah Pelham also is looking for approval to appropriate the additional funds of \$20,000 to cover the budgeted overhead for the next fiscal year related to Tech River.

Doug Jensen made a motion and was seconded by Vanessa Hernandez to approve the appropriated of the \$20,000 to cover the budgeted overhead related to Tech River. Donald Samuels voted no. Motion passed.

**PfMan**

Shawn Okun was here today to update the Board on all of his progress. The building is coming along. The plant manager has also moved to Hardee County. They are looking to hire locally as well as globally. According to Shawn Okun, he is ahead in sales.

**Continuum Labs update**

As per contract, Travis Bond gave his monthly update to the Board. The Caresync app is now available on Android. Travis Bond is still meeting with Venture Capitalists and will be meeting with a Hedge Fund later in the week.

**IDA FRBA Rapid shared costs discussion**

Steven Southwell came before the Board representing Rapid Systems. Background was given as to why Rapid is coming before the Board. Rapid Systems took over costs of the broadband network when FRBA sent a letter stating that they had 30 days to find another carrier. If Rapid Systems had not acted, the broadband fiber conduit would have been cut off in the County. Since Rapid Systems took over the unexpected expenses, they have come today to ask if we could share in the paying of the expenses.

The original Hardee Broadband system was designed with a 400 megabyte broadband supply via microwave from Riverview. With the anticipated needs of FRBA, the broadband supply was increased to 1.2 gigabytes and was sourced from the ILA POP at Ona. The issue for consideration centered around the sharing of costs that occurred as a result of the increase in system capacity that had been expected to be paid for by FRBA.

Donald Samuels made a motion and was seconded by Doug Jensen to deny the sharing of the costs. A roll call vote was taken. The results were 3-4. Motion did not pass by the majority.

LIEN ON PROCEEDS OF LITIGATION

FOR VALUE RECEIVED, the undersigned, RAPID SYSTEMS, INC. ("Maker"), promises to pay to the order of HARDEE COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, ("Holder"), 107 E. Main Street, Wauchula, Florida 33873, or at such other address as the Holder may from time to time specify by written notice to the makers the principal sum of \$127,878.00.

Payment shall be conditioned upon recovery by Maker from Florida Rural Broadband Alliance, LLC, or any successor in interest thereto, or assignee thereof, ("FRBA") on the claims by Maker which are currently pending in the U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Florida, together with any and all other claims subsequently brought by Maker and arising out of the same set of facts and circumstances brought in the same Court or any other Court ("Recovery"). Maker further grants an unconditional lien upon Recovery in favor of Holder until satisfaction or acceptable release is granted by the Holder. Payment shall be due on the earlier of actual receipt of sums related to Recovery or three years from the date of this Note. Notwithstanding any other provision herein, any payments due shall be conditioned upon Recovery.

This note shall be construed and enforced according to the laws of the State of Florida, and is secured by lien on Recovery evidenced by letter of protection of even date herewith.

Each maker and endorser waives presentment, protest, notice of protest, and notice of dishonor, and agrees to pay all costs, including a reasonable attorneys' fee, whether suit be brought or not, if counsel shall after maturity of this note or default hereunder or under said lien, be employed to collect this note or to protect the security thereof: including costs and attorneys' fees incurred on appeal. In the event the makers shall be in default under this obligation, and a trial by jury shall occur as a result thereof, then all accrued interest, court costs and attorneys' fees payable to the holder hereof shall be determined by a court of competent jurisdiction, and not by jury, and shall be taxed as costs to be paid by the makers to the holder hereof.

Makers consent to the issuance of a continuing writ of garnishment or attachment against the disposable earnings of makers, in accordance with Sec. 222.11, Florida Statutes, in order to satisfy, in whole or in part, any money judgment entered in favor of holder.

The undersigned reserve the right to prepay this obligation in full or in part at any time after date without payment of premium or penalty therefor.

Dear Bill:

We are pleased to have the opportunity to assist you in the design and permitting of the HCCP extension. It is understood that the proposed project will be located on the 30.1 acre South tract (Lot C) plus the 104.1 acre Terrell property. The project will entail developing new lots, water, sanitary and storm infrastructure as an extension to the HCCP.

Hunter Engineering (HEI) has familiarized itself with the specific parameters associated with the site and the components of this proposal are based upon our preliminary site layout plan and recent discussions with you.

We have prepared a basic service agreement which includes a scope of work defining the steps we would take to design and permit this project. The basic elements of the Agreement are as follows:

**Scope of Work:**

1. Hunter Engineering, Inc. (HEI) will utilize boundary and topographic survey information as prepared by others within this contract.
2. Using the survey information, a preliminary site layout plan will be prepared illustrating the lot lines, roadways and drainage features. This plan will be reviewed with Hardee County Economic Development IDA (hereinafter referred to as Client) and any changes will be discussed and agreed upon prior to developing detailed construction drawings. (The site layout will make every effort to avoid wetland impacts and respect the approximate 100 year floodplain boundary.)
3. HEI will prepare and submit the re-zoning application & Comprehensive Plan Amendment (CPA) application(s) to Hardee County.
4. Four (4) design coordination / construction meetings will be conducted with the Client and any other affected parties.

5. HEI will prepare detailed site related construction drawings suitable to obtain all necessary permits and suitable to bid and construct the proposed project.

Anticipated permits/approvals include the following:

- Hardee County -Zoning & Comprehensive Plan Amendment.
- Hardee County - Site Development Plan (SDP)/Site Construction Plan (SCP) Approval- for local government approval.
- Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD) - for the Environmental Resource Permit associated with the grading and construction permit.
- Florida Dept. of Environmental Protection (FDEP)- for the NPDES Stormwater Pollution Prevention plan.
- Florida Dept. of Environmental Protection (FDEP) – for Sanitary sewer collection and transmission improvements
- Florida Dept. of Environmental Protection (FDEP) – for Domestic water system improvements
- Project close-out and As-Built certifications for the Hardee County Economic Development Office and other appropriate agencies.

6. HEI will maintain close, timely communication and coordination with the Client and other affected parties.

Examples of Excluded Items:

1. Permit Fees -The Client shall be responsible for all necessary permit fees.
2. Soil borings and/or geotechnical investigations and reports.
3. Flood studies.
4. Traffic studies.
5. Offsite roadway improvements.
6. Offsite utility improvements.
7. As-Built surveys.

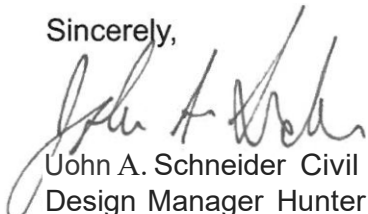

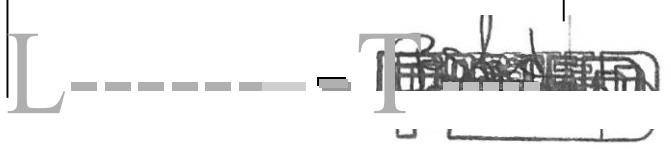
