Our Accomplishments

- Clean Energy Jobs Accelerator
 - Build an Ecosystem to Support Diversification of Central Florida's Economy
- Delivered Results:
 - 238 Jobs over 2 years (goal of 200)
 - 34 companies access financing (goal of 10)
 - Advocated for establishment of Florida Clean Energy Matching Grant program: \$4.5
 Million to match Federal and private foundation funding opportunities
 - Obtained over \$2 million in equipment, and leveraged nearly \$2 billion in existing plant and equipment to support Space and Energy Innovation capabilities in Florida

- Industrial Development Bonds






